Present in Vietnam since 1992, PE&D has implemented education projects for more than 15 years with minority ethnic groups in the North then settled in the South to work on issues of urban poverty, early childhood development, protection against gender based violence and fight against child trafficking.

MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES

The Project Coordinator will work directly with local partners, in particular Capacity Building and Support Centre for Women and Children (CSWC), local authorities such as DOLISA, charity schools, and project beneficiaries.

1. Implementation and development of project activities

- Planification, implementation, and coordination of all project activities according to the project framework documents; The project coordinator is responsible for achieving the objectives set in the project, both qualitatively and quantitatively.
- Setting up the monitoring and evaluation framework and tools
- Monitoring and evaluation of activities and results obtained
- Strong presence in the field
- Reflection on future directions/strategy for the project in collaboration with the country director and PE&D director

2. Management of the project team (3 persons)

- Team leadership and organization of the team's work
- Programming of activities with team members and daily follow-up
- Mobilization of external skills necessary for the project



3. Logistics, administrative and financial management, fundraising

- Ensures the logistics of the project (monitoring of equipment and inventory management)
- Elaboration of the project budget validated by the country director and the finance manager
- Financial follow-up of the project, with the finance manager (planning and control of expenses according to the approved budgets)
- Drafting of activity reports for donors/authorities according to the required formats and within the required deadline
- Drafting of PE&D annual activity report regarding the project
- Active participation in fundraising

4. Communication, coordination and capitalisation

- Coordination with the different technical, financial and institutional partners and the local and national authorities. Supervision and renewal of partnership agreements;
 Development of exchanges of experience and consultation with other housing actors in Vietnam (NGOs, international organizations).
- Collaboration and support to the local partner
- Mission of capitalization
- Active participation in internal and external communication
